Vintage Notes

"The 2019 vintage proved a watershed vintage for Rob Dolan Wines. The climatic conditions in the Yarra Valley leading into vintage were challenging with hot, dry conditions. The vintage was short and intense, being compressed into just six weeks with the winery operating 24 hours a day to ensure grapes were processed at optimum ripeness. You can expect great colour, richness and depth and excellent varietal intensity—certainly my top 5 vintages since 1992.." - *Rob Dolan - Winemaker*

Aroma	citrus, guava, lychee + hints of savoury oak
Palate	tropical fruits with a crisp, dry finish
Cellar	medium term, up to 5 years will be rewarded

Vineyard	Dixons Creek, Chirnside Park + Healesville
Harvest	28th February - 14th March 2019
Method	hand + machine picked

Winemaking

Process	de-stemmed + crushed, with some whole bunch, cold settled + racked to oak
Fermentation	fermented cool in first and second use French oak (40%), balance stainless steel
Barrel	40% matured for 8 months, bottled in November 2019
Alcohol	12.9%
