Vintage Notes

"The 2019 vintage proved a watershed vintage for Rob Dolan Wines. The climatic conditions in the Yarra Valley leading into vintage were challenging with hot, dry conditions. The vintage was short and intense, being compressed into just six weeks with the winery operating 24 hours a day to ensure grapes were processed at optimum ripeness. You can expect great colour, richness and depth and excellent varietal intensity—certainly my top 5 vintages since 1992.." - *Rob Dolan - Winemaker*

Harvest	23rd February 2019 + 1st March 2019
Method	picked on acidity levels, machine harvested

Winemaking

Process	12 hours on skins post crushing to allow juice to pick up natural colour from the skins
Fermentation	20% in barrel on light solids, 80% fermented at 15 degrees Celsius in stainless steel
Alcohol	13.0%
