Vintage Notes

“The 2019 vintage proved a watershed vintage for Rob Dolan Wines. The climatic conditions in the Yarra Valley leading into vintage were challenging with hot, dry conditions. The vintage was short and intense, being compressed into just six weeks with the winery operating 24 hours a day to ensure grapes were processed at optimum ripeness. You can expect great colour, richness and depth and excellent varietal intensity—certainly my top 5 vintages since 1992..” - Rob Dolan - Winemaker

Wine Notes

Colour: Pale straw yellow, with golden hues
Aroma: Citrus, Brioche, Cashew
Palate : Multitudes of fresh fruits including white peach and Citrus with creamy nougat and brioche flavours following. Finishes with a burst of cleansing acidity.
Cellar: Drink now or up to 5 years

Viticulture

Region: Yea Valley and Yarra Valley
Vineyard: Sourced from select vineyards in the Yea Valley and Gruyere in the Yarra Valley
Harvest: Early February
Method : Machine picked in the cool of the evening

Winemaking

Process: Grapes were chilled and pressed upon arrival to the winery.
Juice was clarified and inoculated with sparkling style yeast
Fermentation: Cool fermented in tank and then matured on lees for 15 months
Maloactic: 5 %
Alcohol: 12.0
