Vintage Notes

“The 2019 vintage proved a watershed vintage for Rob Dolan Wines. The climatic conditions in the Yarra Valley leading into vintage were challenging with hot, dry conditions. The vintage was short and intense, being compressed into just six weeks with the winery operating 24 hours a day to ensure grapes were processed at optimum ripeness. You can expect great colour, richness and depth and excellent varietal intensity—certainly my top 5 vintages since 1992..” - Rob Dolan - Winemaker

Vineyard	sourced from select vineyards in Dixons Creek, Yarra Glen, Coldstream, Gladysdale, Gruyere + Chirnside Park
Harvest	early march
Method	hand + machine picked

Process	combination of whole bunch pressed + destemmed/ crushed parcels
Fermentation	partial solids fermented in barrel then aged for 10 months
Maloactic	10%
Alcohol	12.8%
