Colour	Deep blood plum red
Aroma	Blackcurrant, blueberry, clove
Palate	Blackberry, roasted red pepper, fine grained tannins
Cellar	0 to 5 years
Health	88 calories per 120ml glass, < 1 gram of sugar per glass

Occasion

Pile up slices of roasted eggplant, zucchini and roasted red pepper in between layers of sumac sprinkled labneh. Wholesome food deserves a great wine.

Winemaking

Process	All grapes destemmed, crushed and cold soaked for 2 days prior to fermentation
Fermentation	Combination of static fermenters and open pots. Pumped over twice daily.
Alcohol	13.5%
